NATA

National Aptitude Test in Architecture (NATA) is conducted by the council of Architecture (COA) for admission to the first year of 5 year **B. Arch** degree course at all private and government institutions all over the country.

The test measures drawing and observation skills, sense of proportion, aesthetic sensitivity, and critical thinking ability, as well as mathematics. This is a comprehensive evaluation of candidates for undergraduate architecture education (B.Arch).

Admission to all architecture colleges in India is done on the basis of NATA score.

Duration- 5 Year Degree Program Eligibility-

- 10+2 scheme of the examination with at least 50 %
- 10+2 examination with Physics ,Chemistry and Mathematics or 10+3 Diploma with Mathematics as subject of study can appear for NATA 2023.

Master of Architecture. It is a two-year postgraduate professional degree in the field of art and design. Architecture refers to designing a building or any physical structure. It is a full process from the micro level to macro level planning and designing. The course grooms you to be a full-fledged architect.

Duration- 2 Year Degree Program Eligibility -

Candidates should graduate from B.Arch (Bachelor of Architecture) with a minimum grade of 50%.

As per new pattern, there will be only one section in the exam ,meaning the questions are only asked from the aptitude section.

- The drawing section might be removed from the paper for the 2023 exam.
- The question paper will have multiple -choice questions(MCQs),multiple select type questions(MCQs),preferential choice type question PCQs) and numerical answer type questions (NAQs).
- There will be a total of 125 questions for 200 marks.
- There will be no negative marking in NATA 2023
- The exam is conducted only in the English language.

JEE (Main)

The Joint Entrance Examination, JEE (Main) comprises two papers. Paper 1 is conducted for admission to Undergraduate Engineering Programs (B.E/B.Tech.) at NITs, IIITs, other Centrally Funded Technical Institutions (CFTIs), and Institutions/Universities funded/recognized by participating State Governments. JEE (Main) is also an eligibility test for JEE (Advanced), which is conducted for admission to IITs. Paper 2 is conducted for admission to B. Arch and B. Planning courses in the country.

The JEE (Main) – 2023 will be conducted in 02 (two) sessions for admissions in the next academic session. The candidates will thus benefit in the following ways:

- This will give two opportunities to the candidates to improve their scores in the examination if they are not able to give their best in one attempt.
- In the first attempt, the students will get a first-hand experience of taking an examination and will know their mistakes which they can improve while attempting for the second time.
- This will reduce the chances of dropping a year and droppers would not have to waste an entire year.
- If anyone missed the examination due to reasons beyond control (such as the Board examination), then he/she will not have to wait for one entire year.
- A candidate need not appear in both Sessions. However, if a candidate appears in more than one Session then his/her best of the JEE (Main) 2023 NTA Scores will be considered for preparation of the Merit List/ Ranking.

JEE-II(B.Arch)

Paper 2 of the JEE mains ,also known as B.Arch entrance exam are held twice a year usually in January and April. The JEE main paper 2 exam is important for admission to many government and private architecture college in India.

UCEED Eligibility Criteria for applying for B.Des

To apply for admission to the BDes programmes of the participating institutes, i.e., IIT Bombay, IIT Delhi, IIT Guwahati, IIT Hyderabad, and IIITDM Jabalpur, an applicant is required to fulfil ALL the following three criteria simultaneously.

Criterion 1 – Age limit:

The candidate should have been born on or after October 1, 1998 if belonging to the OPEN/EWS/OBC-NCL category and, on or after October 1, 1993 if belonging to the SC, ST or PwD category.

Criterion 2 - UCEED qualification:

The candidate should have qualified, i.e., obtained a rank, in UCEED 2023.

Criterion 3 – Qualifying examination:

The candidate should have passed in all five subjects in the qualifying examination (Class XII or equivalent) in 2022 or 2023. Those who appeared for the first time in their qualifying examination in 2021 or earlier are NOT eligible.

Candidates from the Science Stream with Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics as subjects are eligible to apply to all the five participating institutes (IIT Bombay, IIT Delhi, IIT Guwahati, IIT Hyderabad, and IIITDM Jabalpur). Candidates from any other stream (Science without Mathematics or Physics or Chemistry, Commerce, and Arts & Humanities) are eligible to apply to IIT Bombay, IIT Delhi, and IIT Hyderabad. For admission to BDes at IIITDM Jabalpur, only students with Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics/Biology at 10+2 can apply. Students from Arts or Humanities at 10+2 are not eligible to apply for BDes admissions at IIITDM Jabalpur. Candidates from the Science Stream with Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics as subjects are eligible to apply to IIT Guwahati. Candidates from any other stream (Science without Mathematics or Physics or Chemistry, Commerce, and Arts & Humanities) are NOT eligible to apply to IIT Guwahati.

The candidates appearing for their qualifying examination (Class XII or equivalent) in 2023 should ensure that, (a) all parts of their final examination are completed by the date of application for admission, and (b) proof of having passed the qualifying examination with required eligibility is submitted by September 30, 2023 to the admitting institute.

If a qualifying Examination Board awards only letter grades without providing information on the passing grade on the grade sheet, the candidate should obtain a certificate from the Board specifying the passing grade and upload it along with the grade sheet. In case such a certificate is not provided, the decision taken by the UCI Committee will be final.

The criteria, as specified above, are applicable "in toto" to all the applicants including foreign nationals. Seats allotted to foreign nationals are supernumerary with a cap of 10% of the total seats in a program. Applications from foreign nationals holding OCI/PIO cards are considered under the OPEN category and they are outside the ambit of reservation of seats under the EWS, OBC-NCL, SC, and ST categories.
